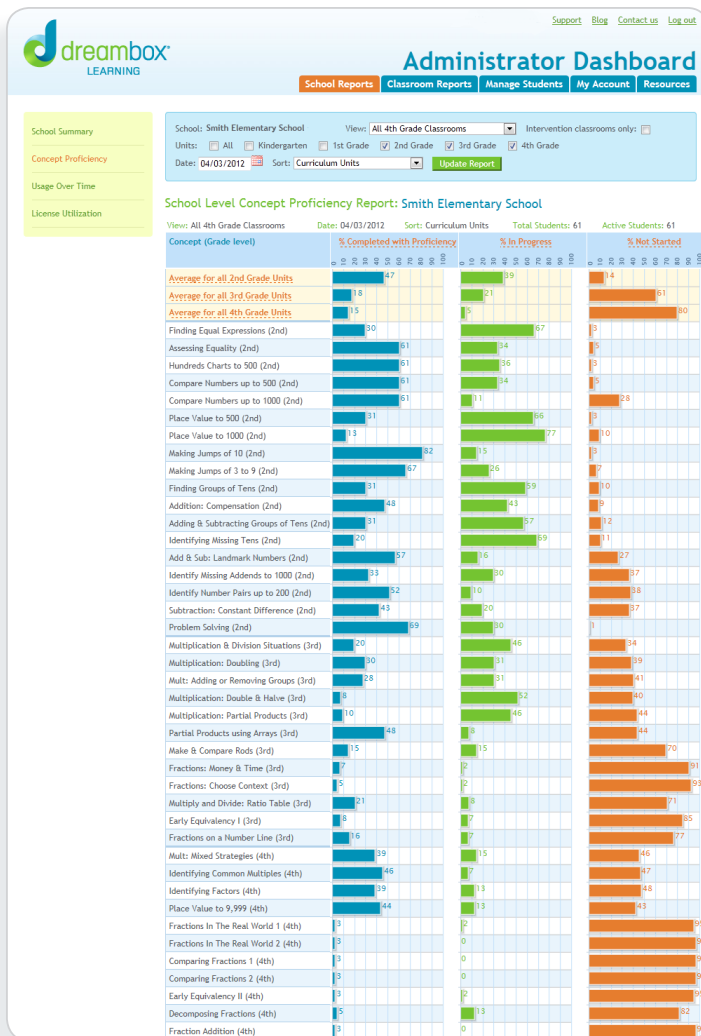


Concept Proficiency Report

QUICK USER GUIDE

The DreamBox Concept Proficiency Report demonstrates proficiency in a new way. You'll gain insight into the progress toward proficiency, know where students are currently working, and what they've accomplished at any given date in time.



Tips for Using Your Concept Proficiency Report

- View concept proficiency for all students in a grade level.** Learn about the strengths and weaknesses of your curriculum. Where do your students excel and where do they need additional support? How do these statistics vary by school? What percent of your 2nd graders are working on first grade curriculum? What percent have completed the unit on Identifying Number Pairs up to 200?
- View progress over time by comparing proficiency reports at different dates.** What did your students know early in the year and what progress have they made over the course of the semester? You can run the report for October 1st to learn that 18% of your Kindergarten students had completed the unit on Comparing 1 to 10. Run the same report for March 1st and see that 68% of your Kindergarten students have now demonstrated proficiency when comparing 1 to 10.
- Sort the proficiency report by units with the largest percent of students in progress.** Did you know that 43% of your 1st grade students are currently working on counting forwards and backwards?
- Compare concept proficiencies across grade level classrooms.** Which classrooms would benefit the most from additional time in the computer lab? Which students need more time learning math in order to achieve grade-level standards?
