What's New: DreamBox now offers two age-appropriate learning environments

Primary learning environment: Kindergarten, first, and second grade students solve math problems while helping their animated friends in story-based adventures.

NEW Intermediate learning environment: Third grade and older students can now explore our new intermediate environment. As students learn, they can earn badges, coins to personalize their music and wallpaper, and they can even unlock new math minigames!

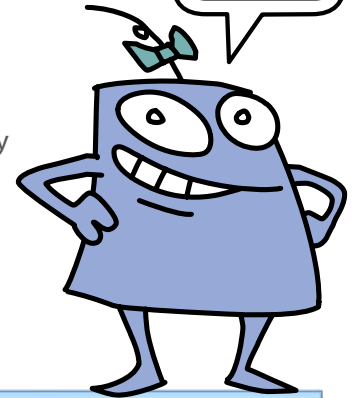
When do students move from the primary to the intermediate environment?

New third grade and older students begin lessons working in the intermediate environment.

Existing students who have been working in the primary environment have two options for moving to the intermediate environment:

1. Students graduate from the primary to the intermediate learning environment when they complete half of the DreamBox 3rd grade curriculum. They see a graduation video and are introduced to the new intermediate environment to access new curriculum.
2. Teachers can move students from the primary to the intermediate environment by using the "Manage Students" tab on their Teacher Dashboards. Simply select the intermediate learning environment for one or all students and save your changes.

Important: Once a student graduates, he or she cannot return to the primary environment.

Does graduation impact a student's position in the curriculum?

No. All DreamBox lessons and units are available in the intermediate environment, starting with the first kindergarten unit on comparing 1 to 10. The DreamBox intelligent adaptive learning™ engine keeps all students in their optimal learning zone regardless of learning environment. When a teacher moves a student from the primary to the intermediate environment, the student simply continues to work on the next appropriate DreamBox lessons. Therefore, a 4th grade student who is working at a 2nd grade level can continue to work through 2nd grade curriculum in an age-appropriate and motivating learning environment.

What new lessons are available in the intermediate environment?

DreamBox has added 100 new lessons and in-depth fractions coverage to the curriculum. The size of our third grade curriculum has doubled, and we have 13 units in our 4th grade curriculum, with more coming soon!
